BRIEF BALLOT PROPOSITION DESCRIPTIONS

- **1 Veterans and Affordable Housing Act.** Issues \$4 billion in bonds for housing programs and veterans' home loans.
- **2 Homeless Housing Bond**. Authorizes state to use revenue from millionaire's tax for \$2 billion in bonds for homelessness prevention projects.
- **3 Water Bond**. Issues \$8.9 billion in bonds for water-related infrastructure and environmental projects.
- **4 Children's Hospital Bond**. Issues \$1.5 billion in bonds for children's hospitals.
- **5 Property Tax**. Revises process for home buyers who are age 55 or older or severely disabled to transfer their tax assessments.
- **6 Gas Tax Repeal**. Repeals 2017 fuel tax and vehicle fee increases and requires public vote on future increases.
- **7 Permanent Daylight Savings Time**. Authorizes legislature to provide for permanent daylight saving time if federal government allows.
- **8 Fair Pricing for Dialysis.** Requires dialysis clinics to issue refunds for revenue above a certain amount.
- **10 Rent Control.** Allows local governments to regulate rent.
- **11 Ambulance Employees Safety.** Allows ambulance providers to require workers to remain on-call during paid breaks.
- **12 Prevention of Cruelty to Farm Animals.** Bans sale of meat from animals confined in spaces smaller than specific size requirements.
